This is a list of some things you could do to campaign with us. But there are lots of other things you could do as well. Your ideas are just as good as ours and it's up to you what you do.

- You could **put up leaflets** in places where lots of people will see them, like a youth club, or school. You should ask permission before doing this. If you want some leaflets, get in touch!
- **Telling your friends about the campaign** could be a great way to let people know about it. Explain to them why you believe in it and tell them that they can get involved too, by contacting Elinor.
- If you use any online message boards, you could **write about the campaign** there. If you read magazines that accept submissions from young people, you could write an article for them about it. Or you could write about it in a school or college newsletter, a local newsletter, and lots of other places.
- You could run a special meeting, for instance in a youth group or another club, to tell people about the campaign. See '**Talking to other people about Children are Unbeatable!**'
- You could write to your MP, or go and talk to them, to let them know what you think. You can write using one of our postcards, or write your own letter. See '**How to contact your MP.**'
- If you don't think you can do any of these things but still want to do something, get in touch – we have a few special jobs that you might be able to do.

Remember that whatever you do, **your campaigning with us makes a real difference!** Children and young people have power when they work together. Together, we can change the world!
